

Administration Targets Massive Regulatory Overhaul

Gov. Mike DeWine and Lt. Gov. Jon Husted announced Thursday a plan to trim the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) by one-third. Husted identified unnecessary and duplicative code sections to be removed totaling 5 million words and 20,000 pages. The plan will be included in the Administration's executive budget proposal to be introduced in the coming weeks.

DeWine Taps New Agency Directors

Gov. Mike DeWine nominated *Rep. Brian Baldridge* to serve as Director of the Ohio Department of Agriculture. Baldridge represents Adams, Scioto, and parts of Brown counties in the 90th House District. He chaired the House Transportation and Public Safety Committee last General Assembly. DeWine also nominated *Patricia Harris* to serve as Ohio Department of Taxation Commissioner. Harris joined the Ohio BWC in 1991 as a claim representative, making her way into leadership as COO in 2020. Both nominations require Senate confirmation.

House Democrats Announced Committee Assignments

Ohio House Democrat Minority Leader Allison Russo has announced the caucus's committee assignments. Representative Bride Sweeney has been tapped as Ranking Member of the House Finance Committee. A full list of assignments can be found attached below.
